the proceeds amongst the complainants and the debtors
and make report thereof to this court in order to a final decree.

On the motion of Jonathan Lister who made oath according
to law for administration on the estate of John Lister decd
the court granted him on his giving bond and security
When upon the said Jonathan Lister with Daniel Sumner
and Joshua Corbitt his securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of five hundred dollars
the said Jonathan and his faithful administration on the estate of
said decedent.

On the motion of Jacob Turner who made oath according
to law for administration on the estate of Nathan Russell decd the court
granted him on his giving bond and security When upon the
said Jacob Turner with Simon Boykin his security entered into
and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars
the said Jacob Turner and his faithful administration on the
estate of the said decedent.
