This day came the parties by attorney and the persons
appointed by a former decree of this court making report in the
following words (to wit) In the name and order of the worshipful
court of Saint Albans, bearing date October 1891 it was ordered
that the subscribers have and have the lands and premises whereof
John Christopher and seized and possessed in manner following
to wit. To Jacob Turner and his wife right we have assigned the
part of land called the great field containing by our survey
two hundred and two acres and valued by us to three dollars
per acre and bounded as follows (viz) Beginning at a light wood post
a corner in Margaret Christopher line thence the said Margaret
line to a pine a committee in David Christopher line whence the said
David line to a gun in the long branch stream up the said Branch to
a pine a committee in William Beal line ^{thence} a straight line of marks
thus to the beginning We have also assigned to him another part of ground
viz Surveyed and valued by us to one hundred Dollars - - - - -
To John Christopher we have assigned that part of the land known
by the name of the Dog's track containing by our survey two
hundred and two acres and valued by us to one dollar per acre
and bounded as follows (viz) Beginning at a white oak a corner tree in
Benjamin Griffins line thence the said Benjamin Griffins line to the
cattail swamp thence up the said swamp to the said Griffins line
thence the said Griffins line to Benjamin Bradshaws line thence
the said Bradshaws line to a pine a committee in Thosus Powell
thence the said Powells line to an oak in William Brantines
