This day came the parties by their attorneys and
the persons appointed by a former decree of this court made their re-
port in following words to wit. Agreeable to an order of the Honorable
court of Southampton bearing date November 1802 we have
proceeded to lay off the lands of Judith Rockell plaintiff against
Thomas Gilliam as follows to wit beginning at a black walnut
just below the lower end of the apple orchard thence south east
one degree east thirty two pole to a persimmon tree thence north south
one degree each forty eight pole to a stake thence north eighty degrees
east twenty five pole to a dyke now a cane thence south eighty
degrees
