and interest at 5 per cent from the 25 day of Dec 1792 - - -

and a credit in the account of twenty dollars 29 day 1793 &

Whereupon the said Josef Broome with James Brannon, Whittington

Broome, James Wilkinson, Canard Broome and Samuel Broome

his securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the

penalty of thirty thousand dollars for the said Josef Broome

and his faithful collection of the tax imposed by law in this

County and other bonds in the penalty of ten thousand dollars

for the performance of the office of collector and the collection
of the county tax &c - - -
