In obedience to the within order of the honorable court of Southampton County, held in the month of January 1803 We have proceeded to divide the slaves wharf Mrs Jones did seized and possessed as follows. To Elizabeth Jones we have allotted Moses, Chances Roger, Sarah, and Cherry. To Abington James jr Dempsey, Jacob, Tanny and Suky and to receive twenty seven pence, which sum the said Elizabeth is to pay. Certified under our hands this 18th day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and three. Matthew Calvert William Woodward and John Hedger. Commissioners.

Whereupon it is deemed and ordered that the report of said be made the same of this must and be firm and stable notwithstanding the parties and the costs take equally to some among them.
