

An Indenture of bargain and sale between William Wood and Elizabeth his wife of the one part and Lazarus Cobb of the other part was acknowledged by William Wood and with the commission for the privy examination of Mr. Wood and certificate of its execution returned and ordered to be recorded

On the motion of John Jones who made oath according to law for administration of the estate of William Jones dec^d the same is granted him on his giving bond and security Whereupon the said John Jones with Isaac Jones his security interdicts and acknowledged their bond in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars for the said John Jones and for faithful administration of the estate of the said decedent

Ordered that Michael Ellis Brister Williams Daniel Butts and John Simmons or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for this county as appraisers in and among the slaves of any one person and estate of William Jones dec^d and return the appraisements to this court

On the motion of Arthur Turner who made oath according to law for injunction to stay the proceedings of a judgment at common law obtained against him by Richard P. Clements the same is granted him on his giving bond and security in an amount to

Ordered that the court be adjourned till court in course
