An Indenture of bargain and sale between Joseph Benson of the one part and Mary his wife Richard Allen and Priscilla his wife of the other part was acknowledged by Joseph Benson and Priscilla his wife of the one part and William Benson of the other part was proved by the oath of John Lee Miller Esq. and Joseph Williams three of the justices of the peace and with the commission for the privy examination of its execution returned and ordered to be recorded.

On the petition of Benjamin Davis who made oath according to law for administration in the estate of Joseph Davis the said Benjamin Davis his giving bond and security Whereupon the said Benjamin Davis with Simon Baykin his security entered into and acknowledged the instrument in the privacy of said court as being for the Benjamin Davis and faithful administration on the estate of the said deceased.

Ordered that Robert Evans Richard B. Wells William Love and Melchior Pittman or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for this county as appraisers in money the slaves if any and personal estate of Joseph Davis and return the appraisement to the next court.

An Indenture of bargain and sale between Priscilla Benson of the one part and Daniel Smith of the other part was acknowledged by Priscilla Benson the party thereto was ordered to be recorded.
