This day came the parties by their attorneys  
and the persons appointed by a former decree of this court made  
their reports in the following words to wit, agreeable to an order  
We have divided the slaves Ann and her child, make Will  
Patience, Jack, and Tom, into four equal parts and assigned  
one part, the one to Charles Freeman and Rebecca his wife and  
one part to John Hart and one part to Charles Hart and the other part  
to Patsy Hart, Peggy Hart, Pilly Hart and Hamlin Hart  
In presence of our hands this 28<sup>th</sup> May 1863 William  
Hartley John Booth and Richard Hart. Whereupon it is  
ordered and decreed that the reports aforesaid be made the decree of this  
court and be firm stable and binding between the parties and that the  
same be equally ben in amongst them
