The defendant by his attorney comes and defends force and injury &c and says that he hath performed ^{the} covenants in the declaration mentioned and he is not indebted to the plaintiff as against him he hath compliance and thus he prays may be acquitted of by the country and the plaintiff likewise and thereupon let a jury come to wit Matthew Surfer Henry Person William Daughtrey Jesse Stephens Jarrett Westbrook Jun^r Bristol Thomas Westbrook Arthur Turner Jesse Williford Wells Mauntpark Henry Pittsney and Matthew Johnston who being elected tried and sworn the truth to speak upon the issue joined upon their oaths to say that the defendant has not performed the conditions of the covenants in the declaration mentioned and thus as ass^t the plaintiff damages by occasion thereof to one hundred dollars and his costs by him about his suit in this behalf expended therefore it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover his damages aforesaid in form aforesaid ass^d and his costs by him about his suit in this behalf expended and the defendant in mercy &c On the motion of the
