

The person appearing to take administration of the estate of Joseph
 Wright therefore on the motion of General Justice Smith it is
 ordered that the sheriff of this county take into his hands
 the said Estate and administer the same according to Law
 and the will and testament of Joseph Wright deceased was presented
 to the court by John Wright the executor thereof named pro &
 by the oaths of John Crumpler and Joseph Donitt two of
 the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded and an abso-
 lution of the said Executor who made oath according to law
 certificate is granted him for obtaining probate thereof
 in due form giving bond and security Whereupon the said
 John Wright with Another Deed his security interest into
 and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of three thousand
 Dollars for the s^d John's due and faithful administration in
 the estate of the s^d deceased and performance of his will
 Ordered that John Crumpler William Crumpler Jacob Turner
 and James Johnson or any three of them being first sworn before
 a justice of the peace for this county do appraise and secure
 money the slaves if any and personal estate of Joseph Wright
 and and return the return the appraisement to this court
 And the return of bargain and sale between John Simmons of the
 one part and Francis Clements of the other part was acknow-
 ledged by John Simmons the party thereto and ordered to be
 Recorded
 And the return of bargain and sale between James Crutcher of
 the one part and John Taylor of the other part was proved
 by the oaths of Miles Cary Elias Williamson and Edward
 Cammels the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded
