 of the estate of Benj^d Turner dec^d and make report thereof
 to this court

A Bill of sale between John Daughtrey of the one part and
 John Dorlow of the other part was acknowledged by John
 Daughtrey the party thereto and ordered to be recorded

A Deed in trust between Henry Davis of the one part and
 William Hargis guards and to Ann Hargis of the other part was ac-
 knowledged by Henry Davis the party thereto and ordered to
 be recorded

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On the motion of Jesso Brown gentleman high sheriff of this
 county Josiah Kirby was sworn his under sheriff

The persons appointed to let the repairs of the Aspinwall bridge having
 reported that the same was let to John Williams for the sum of forty
