 such part of the amount payable in nine months & the remaining
 half payable in eight months and that the Com^{rs} provide
 for said view the improvements made on the said lands
 by John Brechtlaw and make reports of the amount thereof
 in order to a final decree.

Ordered that the cause be adjourned for half past
