was acknowledged by W^m Kirby she being first privately sworn
as the law directs and having been before proved by the oaths
of Henry Porter Jacob Porter and Benjⁿ Turner the witnesses
therein and ordered to be recorded.

An Indenture of bargain and sale between Benjⁿ Porter and Mary his
wife of the one part and Rob^t Ricks of the other part was proved by
the Abolitionists and with the commission for the private examination
of the Court and ordered to be recorded.
