In the motion of Nancy Marks who made oath according to Law for administration on the estate of John Marks dec'd the same is granted her on giving bond and security. Whereupon the said Nancy Marks with Richard Marks and Joseph Marks her securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars for the said Nancy and faithful administration on the estate of the said dec'd and named that Randolph Versum Richard P. Clements Saml. Barham and Frederick Parker or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for this county or appraisers in current money the slaves and personal estate of John Marks and return the appraisements to the Courts
