In the motion of Nancy Marks who made oath according to Law for an administration on the estate of John Marks dec'd, the same is granted to her on giving bond and security, whereupon the said Nancy Marks with Richard Marks and Joseph Marks her securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars for the said Nancy and faithful administration on the estate of the said dec'd

It is ordered that Randolph Newsum, Richard P. Clements, Saml. Barlow and Frederick Parker or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for this county do appraise in current money the slaves, things and personal estate of John Marks and return the appraisements to the Courts
