

18 And said matters of bargain and sale between John Womble & Lucy his wife of the one part and Joseph Bailey of the other part was acknowledged by John Womble and Lucy his wife the being first privately examined as the law is directed to be recorded

It appearing to the court that William Blake a native of South Carolina in possession of negroes Cato and Henry who were taken and as a pretence sold from John Derrington whom no title alleged and who it appears to the Court is an insolvent and being slaves devised them from Nelson Edwards to Sally Edwards his wife her natural life & in remainder to her two children in fee to wit Polly and Rebecca Edwards one of whom is a female slave the other a female white whose husband is incapable of managing his estate and it also appearing to the court that the widow of the said Nelson Edwards hath departed this life and that the slaves in question were unlawfully & secretly sold as aforesaid by the said John Derrington to the said Blake who has them now in possession and on his way to South Carolina. Therefore it is ordered that the Sheriff take the said Cato and Henry into his care and them safely keep untill the further Orders of this Court

And the Sumner is by the court appointed proceper in the debt at S in the term of Mr Barrow who is removed
