Lydia, married Hannah and by letters as her executors by the s.^t
decrees we are directed all which we respectfully submit to
the said County Court given under our hands this 11th day
of December 1803 - Jordan Williams Eliza Gardner and
Sarah Bennett - Whereas upon it is deemed and ordered that the
report aforesaid be made the decree of this Court and be firmly sealed
and binding between the parties and that the Court be equally be
borne among them.
