decree we are directed all which we respectfully submit to
the said County Court, Give under our hands this 22nd day
of December 1803—Jordan Williams Elder, Gardener and
Isaac B. Broomall—Whereupon it is decreed and ordered that the
report aforesaid be made the decree of this Court and be firm stable
and binding between the parties and that the Court be equally be
honest among them
