by Charles Bryant the executor thereto named provided by the will of  
Frederick Robertson from which and Dixon, Coffey the attorney thereunto  
named and ordered to be recorded and on the motion of the said  
executor who made oath according to law certificate is granted to  
him for obtaining a probate thereof in due form with his giving  
bond and security whereupon the said Charles Bryant with  
Nath'l Robertson and Frederick Robertson his securities entered  
into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of five thousand  
dollars for the said Charles Bryant and faithful administration of  
the estate of the said decedent and performance of his Will.

Ordered that Nathan Williams Charles Birdsong Peter Lane and

sworn before a justice of the peace for this county do appraise in

to law.

privately examined at the law office and ordered to be recorded.
