 Cato to be paid by Betty £3.15.1 by Solomon £2.10.0 to £106.5.0

 paying to Elias £60.00 to Cherry £2.10.0 to £106.5.0
 That the value of slaves to be divided amongst four children £42.5-
 with respect to the remaining two thirds of the land which by the
 said decedent's Commissioners are directed to divide equally
 amongst the heirs we beg leave to state in our opinions of it be-
 ing so divided each dividend would not amount in value to one
 hundred dollars, in which case your commissioners are advised
 that the law will direct that the land should be sold to the
