Ordered that John Clayton, Shadrach Bykin and William
Lowrie examine the estate and debts of Robert Edmund account of his ad-
ministration on the estate of Robt. Shield dec'd and make
report thereof to this Court

On the motion of Henry Parker for leave to keep a tavern at his
Josiah Nicks house in Jerusalem on the 17th the same is
granted him on his giving bond and security whereupon the
said Henry Parker with his security
entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of
one hundred and fifty dollars for the said Henry Parker
keeping the said ordinary according to Law

On the motion of James Brocklaw for leave to keep a tavern at
his house in Jerusalem the same is granted him on his giving
bond and security whereupon the said James Brocklaw with

his giving bond and security whereupon the said James
Polk with his security entered into
and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of one hundred

said ordinary according to Law
