This day came the parties by their attorney and the
persons appointed by a former decree of this Court this day made
their report in the following words to wit Pursuant to a decree
of the Court of Savoy (a copy of which is hereto annexed) in this
case of the Commissioner herein named have attested a signed and
set apart to Mitchy Westro Sixty three acres of land bounded
as follows (to wit) Beginning at a large pine in a low in Soriac
Cobb line running thence along said Cobb line to Nicholas
Cobb thence along Nicholas Cobb to David Cawards line, thence
along David Cawards line James Gordan's line thence along said
Gardner's line to William Baker's line thence along said Baker's
line to a white oak, a corner, thence S. eastwardly along a line of
marked trees to a pine a corner thence eastwardly along a line of
marked trees to a pine standing in the side of a pond near the
plantation thence S. eastwardly through the plantation to a per-
simmon tree a corner, thence S. eastwardly through the fields oppo-
site thereto and woods a straight line to Jacob Cobb line thence said
Cobb line to the first station, as her dower in the lands of which
William Westro Junr died seized and possessed before his death
of said land we have apportioned to Mary B. Westro as her said
dower as directed, Given under our hands the 31st day of
January 1804 - Jordan Williams Jacob Dardia Price Moore
Whereupon it is decreed and ordered that the report aforesaid be
made the decree of this court and be from thenceforward binding
between the parties and that the cost be equally borne among them.
