The above named John P. Pittway this day appeared in discharge of his recognizance and it is ordered that he find security for the maintenance of the said child. Whereupon the said Jas. Parker Pittway with Charles B. Nicholson his security entered into and acknowledged the following bond under seal of John Page Esquire Governor of this Commonwealth and his two cojors in the sum of thirty pounds and the security in the sum of fifty pounds of their respective lands tenements goods and chattels to be sued upon that Condition that if the said John P. Pittway shall pay the aforesaid sum of thirty pounds that is tenay five pounds annually for six years to the overseers of the poor for the maintenance of the said child then this obligation to be paid or Else to remain in full force and virtue—
