and twenty five dollars and have taken his bond & sufficient
security for the said amount payable as the said order directed
We have also valued the improvements made on the said Land
which is as underneath to wit For building the said mill
two hundred and twenty dollars one pair of mill stones
seventy dollars expenses of hauling with fifteen dollars
for the mill work and hauling with one hundred and fifty dollars
dollars provisions one hundred and sixty two dollars for
work for the mill twenty dollars mill house fifty dollars
