persons appointed by a former decree of this court this day made
their report in the following Work to be done

I do subscribe to the aforesaid order of the Worshipful court
of Southampton bearing date September last 1803 to wit in that
the subscribers have divided the sum of one hundred pounds
of Thomas Simmons deceased in the Mill tract of Land and have
assigned one moiety to the said Brightlow in right of Daniel
Simmons his paying the difference in valuation of his
moiety of sixteen pounds seventeen shillings and nine pence
out of the said orphans and have made sale of the other moiety
which is purchased by Bulard Simmons for six hundred
and twenty five dollars and have taken his bond sufficient
security for the said amount payable as the said orphans
will have also valued the improvements made on the said Land
which is as underneath to wit for building the said Mill
two hundred and twenty dollars one pair of Mill Stones
one hundred dollars expense of hauling with fifteen dollars
for levelling work and hauling with one hundred and forty two
dollars providing one hundred and forty two dollars from
a work for the mill twenty dollars mill house fifty dollars
