 against Augustus Pope for the sum of eighty six dollars and twenty two
 Cents in full of my proportion of the product of the sales of said estate
 Moses Pope. Whereupon it is ordered and ordered that the report
 aforesaid be made the order of this court and be firm stable binding
 between the parties and that the costs be equally borne among them

Ordered that the order made at October court 1803 appointing William
 Edwards overseer of the road from Jones mill swamp to the Cy press
 swamp be recalled and that he be appointed from the said Jones mill
 swamp to the cedar swamp including one of the hollow bridges and it
 is ordered that he with the male laboring tickets belonging to
 the said road keep it in repair according to Law

On the motion of Samuel Calvert for leave to take up a return at his house
 in Jerusalem the same is granted him on his giving bond and security
 whereupon the said Samuel Calvert with Benjamin Cobb his
 security entered into and acknowledge themselves in the penalty of one
 hundred and fifty dollars for the said Samuel Calvert the pen^y
 the said ordinance according to Law

Isaac M. Moore is by the court appointed overseer of the road in the room
 of John Knuts who is discharged and it is ordered that he with the
 male laboring tickets belonging to the said road keep it in repair
 according to Law

Williamy Reeds is by the court appointed overseer of the road in the room of
 Henry W. Norrill and therefore it is ordered that he with the male laboring
 tickets belonging to the said road keep it in repair according to Law

Ordered that the court be adjourned till tomorrow the 11th clock
