

The last will and testament of Samuel Woodard Sen^r dec^d, as presented into Court by John Woodard the executor therein named proved by the oaths of Asa Beal and Nicholas Popple of the county aforesaid and ordered to be recorded and on the motion of the said executor who made according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form on his giving bond and security whereupon the said John Woodard with David Washington and Nathaniel English his securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars for the said In^r Woodard Sen^r and faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent and performance of his will

Ordered that John Day Benjamin Mr. Whitner Sam^l Cannon and John Johnson or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for this county do appraise in current money the lands and goods personal estate of Samuel Woodard Sen^r dec^d, and return the appraisement to this Court

On the motion of William Hart who made oath according to law for admission as executor on the estate of Brambley Hunnisutt dec^d the same is granted to him on his giving bond and security whereupon the said William Hart with Samuel Kates and Benjⁿ Collier his securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars for the said William Hart dec^d and faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent

Upon the motion of Dick Bishop and Peter his wife and William his child by Richard Mr. Boyd their attorney and it appearing to the satisfaction of the court that they are indebted to their friend during the life of Sam Bishop, therefore do order that In^r George and all others be prohibited from committing any act of alienation or of the said negroes during the life time of the said Sam Bishop without the further order of this Court and it is further ordered that the Sheriff keep the said negroes in his possession until the said In^r George give him bond and security in the sum of one thousand dollars
