The jury who were summoned to lay off the line in dispute between Miles Carey and Robert Miller this day made their report in the following words (to wit) pursuant to the annexed order of Court bearing date March Court 1804 we the undersigned, sheriff and jury being first sworn, have attended on a disputed line between Robert Miller and Miles Carey, to wit beginning at a pine standing on the west side of Buck Horn swamp on the edge of the low grounds at a corner tree between said Miller and the said Carey and running N 1/2 East 44 poles to the mouth of the long branch, then wrap the various courses of said branch to white oak, where the disputed line first began and do further say that from said white oak, along a disputed line of marked trees to the beginning ought to be made and void
