An Indenture of bargain and sale between Sether Jones, late Woodard widow of Samuel Woodard dec^d formerly late Jones, Nancy Jones joint heirs by Sether Jones dec^d of the one part and William Jones of the other part was proved by the oaths of Mary Griffin, Miles Shumaker and Pringle Barnde the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.

An account current of the estate of Sether Jones dec^d was this day signed by the persons appointed to settle the said estate and ordered to be recorded.
