Creasey's information, we present the surveyor of the road
from Black creek to Black water bridge for 1/2 a mile
the same in repairs by the information of Henry Dawson
we present the surveyor of the roads from Jerusalem to Winton
a ramp for 1/2 mile by William Jones and Presley Barnett
we present James Frichlow for suffering unlawful gaming
in his house on the 23rd & 24th of May by John
Morris, Abigail Jones, William Mugrick, we present the
surveyor of the roads from the old County line to the park at
Jordan Williams by Jordan Williams and the information
of both we present the surveyor of the road from the park
of the roads to Southeying also the surveyor from the park
a ramp to the old County line on Southeying road by Jordan
