bonds in the penalty of six thousand dollars for the said John
McCreary and his faithful administration on the estate of the
said decedent

Ordered that Nathaniel Pitty James Douglas James Irvine and
Spratley Williams or any three of them being first sworn before
justices of the peace for this County do appraise in current money the
share of any and personal estate of Antonio Gilestani decd and
return the appraisement to this Court

On person applying for administration on the estate of William (John)
and it is ordered that the sheriff of this County take the said
into his hands and administer thereon according to law and it is
further ordered that he make sale of the perishable part of the
said estate on a credit of Nine Months taking bond security
of purchaser do

Richard Eglst Williams is by the Court appointed overseer of the road
