

212 At a Court held for the County of Sampson on the 13<sup>th</sup> day  
of July 1864.

In the matter of John H. Gray, whom also hath according  
law for administration on the estate of Antonio Gibertini et al.  
the same is granted him on his giving bond and security where  
upon the said John H. Gray with Theodore Hart and Wm  
Leonard his securities entered into and acknowledged certain  
bond in the penalty of six thousand dollars for the said John H.  
Gray to have made a faithful administration on the estate of the  
said decedent.

Ordered that Nathaniel Pitt Lamm Douglas James Irvin and  
Spartus Williams or any three of them being first sworn before  
justice of the peace for this County do appraise in current money the  
slaves if any and personal estate of Antonio Gibertini et al. and  
return the appraisement to this Court.

Whereas applying for administration on the estate of William E. Holt  
\$100 it is ordered that the sheriff of this county take the said into  
his hands and administer the same according to law and so  
further ordered that he make sale of the personal effects of the  
said estate on a credit of Nine Months taking bond security  
of purchasers to
