The prisoner George having been committed to the Gaol of this County was set to the bar by the Sheriff and charged with the felony of fraud and perjury writings being examined the Court on consideration thereof and all the circumstances of the Case are of opinion that the prisoner is not guilty therefore it is ordered that he be forthwith discharged
