whereof Party Thorp was a owner of hermitah Thorp did
in possession of amongst the complainants and defendants have divided
and allotted the said land in the manner following vizt to John
Clark, seventy two acres and bounded as follows, beginning at a black
oak corner of the road, then north forty degrees east one hundred
eighty eight pole to a white oak in Robbins branch, then up
the branch to the road, then along the road to the beginning to
Timothy Thorp seventy four acres and bounded as follows beginning at
the red oak, Clark, corner then north forty degrees East one hundred
eighty eight pole to a white oak in Robbins branch, then down the
said branch to a sweet gum then a south seventy one degrees West
to the beginning. To James Thorp (not otherwise to James Hanan) thirty
four acres and bounded as follows beginning at a sweet gum in
Robbins branch, then south twenty one degrees West one hundred
and seventy pole to a marsh at the road then up the said road to a
small red oak then one hundred and eighty pole to a pine in
the fork of the pond then to the sweet gum the beginning, to Felix
Spano or otherwise called Pason thirty four acres and bounded as follows
beginning at a corner red oak at the road, then one hundred and eighty
pole to a pine in the fork of the pond then one hundred and eighty two
pole to a pine a corner then to the beginning. To Joseph Thorp thirty
two acres beginning at a pine in Thorps lot line then along the said
line to a stump then south seventy degrees West ninety five pole
