

An Indenture of bargain and sale between James Byrd and Sarah his wife of the one part and Henry Blount of the other part was acknowledged by James Byrd and Sally his wife the being first sworn examined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded

An Indenture of bargain and sale between Shadock Lewis of the one part and Lemuel Lewis of the other part was proved by the oaths of John Davis and having been before proved by the oaths of Shells Lewis and Eliza Lewis two other witnesses and ordered to be recorded

Ordered that Daniel Simmons Nathan Seiner and Joseph Dimes or any two of them in conjunction with persons appointed by Salsburgh Court view the repairs done to Black water bridge at Salsburgh the Court house and make report thereof to this Court

The last will and testament of Thomas English dec'd was proved in Court by John English the executor thereof and was proved by the oaths of Peterway Shivers Harry Lawrence and Samuel Forbitt the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded and on the motion of the said executor who made a declaration to save satisfaction is granted him for obtaining a probate thereof in due form on his giving bond and security whereupon the said John English with Samuel Forbitt and Peterway Shivers his securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars for the said John English and for his administration on the estate of the said decedent and performance of his will

Ordered that Daniel Simmons Harry Lawrence Peterway Shivers and Henry Jones or any three of them being first sworn before justice of the peace for this County to appraise or Current the slaves of any personal estate of Thomas English dec'd and return the appraisement to this Court

On the motion of John Dungey for leave to keep a tavern at his house in Salsburgh the same is granted him on his bond and security whereupon the said John Dungey with James Schell his security entered
