this County and charged with the offence aforesaid was brought into
Court and deposes and swears and commits on behalf of the de-

disposal to the Court on consideration thereof and all the circumstances
of the case are of opinion that the prisoners ought to be tried
at the next Justice Court to be held in Suffolk
