It appearing to the Court by the information of Richard Bleat, assistant commissioner of the revenue that Henry Tilley late refused to give his list of negro property therefore it is ordered that he make his fine with the Commonwealth by the payment of fifteen dollars according to an act of Assembly in that case made and provided and that he pay the cost of this prosecution.

Samuel Calvert is by the Court appointed commissioner of the revenue for this County for the ensuing year.
