David Washington be of good behavior to all the Citizens of this
Commonwealth and especially to the Clergy, Washington for the space
of ^{three} calendar months from this day then the design was to be void

On the motion of Henry Amington Westrop for the Commonwealth
against Thomas Thomas alias Thomas Africa it is ordered that
the Sheriff of this County pay him fifty three Cents for one day
and an another Cent according to Law

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till tomorrow 9th Clock
