

At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 15th day of October 1804

A deed of trust between Walter Linc Jenkins of the One part and In^o Vagahast of the other part was proved by the oaths of two of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved by In^o Cook and the witness is ordered to be recorded

On the motion of Thomas Mollasay for administration on William Benson's estate it is ordered that the motion be overruled & apply to the Court that the said Benson had not been dead 30 days

On the motion of Henry Hart who made oath according to law for administration on the estate of William Hart deceased the same is granted him on his giving bond and security Whereupon the said Henry Hart with his secret entered into and acknowledged bond in the penalty of \$1000 for the said Henrys due and faithful administration on the estate of the decedent

Ordered that Samuel Magette Sife Batch Spence Pence and Richmond Dillards or any three hereof first sworn before a justice of the peace for this County do appraise in current money the Slaves if Any And personal estate of W^o Hart decd and return the Appraisement to this Court

Jane Edwite orphan of Etheldreda Edwite came into Court and chose Saml Magette her guardian whereupon the S^d Samuel with his secret entered into y^e known dollar

pledges their bond in the penalty of \$1000 for securing the Orphans estate and indemnification of this Court

The last will and testament of Hannan Harris decd was presented in Court by the executor thereunto named proved by two witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded And on the
