her securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of dollars for the said Charlottes due and faithful administration on the estate of the decedent. Ordered that Humphry Dickey Benj. Blunt James Dwyer and William Ricks or any three of them being first sworn as the law directs do appraise in Current money the slaves and other personal estate of Thomas Turner and return the same to the Court.

An Indenture of bargain and sale between John of the one part and John of the other part was proved by the oath of one of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be ~~recorded~~ for further proof.
