Next on the roll and answer, on consideration whereof it is decreed and ordered that Robert Malby Samuel Blount et al. comprising Dorsey and Esch Turner or any three of them, together with the County surveyor as ex^rs of the land in the bill mentioned whereby Thomas Turner dec^d died and possessed in six equal parts severally and assigning to the defendant Charlotte her share (or one third part) therein, having regard to the quantity and quality of the said land in making the aforesaid division and allotment, and it is further decreed and ordered that the commissioners aforesaid do settle the defendant on their part of the slaves belonging to the said estate (for her life) and divide the residue in six equal parts among the complainants and make report thereof in respect to a final decree
