 of the witnesses thereto and ordered

An Indenture of bargain and sale between John A. Brown and Sally  
 his wife of the one part and Thomas Newsum of the other part was ac-  
 knowledged by the said John A. Brown and Sally his wife the living  
 first, jointly and severally as the law directs and ordered to be recorded

 in court by Benjamin M. Brown and Jos Brown the executors therein  
 named proved by the oaths of John Brown, John Squire, and James
