 river, and bound as follows beginning at a gum on deep creek a corner of
 James Magrick's line, thence along said James line to smother in river, thence
 down the said river to an oak, thence N. 5 degrees East, to an Elm
 on James Lunday's line, thence West along said Lunday's line to a white
 oak on deep creek, thence up said creek to the beginning, also four negroes
 Wm. Lewis, Peter, Clary, Lucy, and Sucky to receive the sum of one
 pound, fifteen shillings and six pence, of James Magrick one pound
 nine shillings and Mary Ann Magrick the sum of six shillings and
 six pence - to Mary Ann Magrick another of the complainants 76
 of the townships of smother in river, and bound as follows to wit
 beginning at an Elm a corner of Susanna Magrick's line, thence along
 said Susanna's line to the river, thence down the said river to a Walnut
 tree on the bank of said river, thence a dividing line N. 11 degrees
 East to a hickory tree on James Lunday's line, thence West along the
 said Lunday's line to the beginning - also four negroes Wm. Matthew
 Chancy, Rockers, and Sucky, and to pay Susanna Magrick six shillings
 and six pence - to Edmund D. Magrick, one of the defendants 6 Acres
 of land in the townships of Mackerron, and bound as follows, beginning
 at a Walnut tree on the bank of the said river, thence N. 1 degree
 East along the line of Mary Ann Magrick's to a hickory a corner
 of said Edmund's & along down, on James Lunday's line thence along
 Lunday's line East to a dead oak a corner of said Lunday's line thence
 along said Lunday's line South 126 poles to a persimmon tree on the
 bank of said river, thence up the said river to the beginning, also four negroes
 Wm. James, Jacob, Carter, and Sucky, to receive of David Magrick
 the sum of four pounds five shillings and six pence, which decreed at
 order is, hereto annexed, upon which also have a fair and correct
 plot of the survey said lands, which by map, be considered as a
 part of our report, which is hereto annexed, Given under our hand

 William Wright - Whereupon it is decreed and ordered that the report
 annexed be made the record of this court and be firm stable, and binding
 the parties into that the cuts be equally bound among them
