One another writing also purporting to be the last will and testament
of John Johnson dated in the year 1808 was proved by the oath
of John Griffon one of the witnesses thereto and the said John
Griffon deposed that he saw Willis Griffon another witness
who is since dead subscribe his name to the said will at

With motion of Justice Holloman for administration to

to Law the same is granted him on giving bond
