

William's Vicks and if it be necessary that they call the County Surveyor to their aid and make report to this Court in order to a final decree

By consent of the parties, it is ordered that Henry Bacon Samuel Belmont Ethelred Edmunds and William Blen among others of whom being first sworn before the Justice of the peace for the County de Appraise in current money the value of any and several estate of Wendell Vaughan due to and that they divide the said estate amongst those entitled to the same in the following manner (to-wit) one third of the personal property of the said Wendell Vaughan (absolutely) and one third of the Land and Slaves of the said decedent for life to Lewis Wright in right of his wife Rebecca formerly Rebecca Vaughan and widow of the said Wendell Vaughan, and divide the residue of the estate of the said Wendell Vaughan between Thomas Drane in right of his wife Mary and Fanny Vaughan and make report to this Court

An Indenture of bargain and sale between John Livingston and Sulphur his wife of the one part and Henry Livingston of the other part with a Comersum for the procuring execution of the said John Livingston and certificate of its execution was returned and proved by the oath of Robert George and Daniel White two of the witnesses thereto and contained therein that the contents of the foregoing and last will and testament of John Livingston were true and correct according to Law

The last will and testament of John Livingston deceased was read in Court by William Livingston one of the executors therein named and proved by the oath of the other one of the executors appearing as qualified persons by the oath of James Jones one of the witnesses thereto and having been proved
