But it remembered that Henry Doyal and Samuel Calvert of the County of Southampton Committed Creditors and Personally acknowledge themselves to be indebted to John Page Esquire Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia and to his Successors for the time being in the sum of three hundred and thirty four dollars each of their respective lands and Tenements Goods and Chattels to be devised and to the said Governor and his Successors for the use of the Commonwealth hereunto byt upon this Condition that the said Henry Doyal and Samuel Calvert son of the above bound Samuel Calvert do and shall personally appear before the Justice of this County at the next Quarterly Court at the Court house in the town of Jamestown then and there to give such evidence as they and each of them know against John Page the Prisoner as the law concerning the matter hereinwith his charge and that they do not depart with out leave of that Court then the recognizance to be void else to remain in full force and Virtue
