was offered by Hardy Colly Attorney for the said black man who
offered in evidence sundry Papers N. 2.3.4.5 & 6 as proof
that the said Jack Honesty might be discharged in Consideration whereof
the Court being satisfied upon the Testimony offered that the said Jack
Honesty came within the Meaning and purview of the before recited act
they do order that the said Jack Honesty be sold as far as relates
to the intent of Slave English who claim agreeable to the said
act of Assembly, and it is further ordered that the Sheriff provide and sell
the said negro Jack according to Law
