

90 pieces of silver to the value of thirty shillings, contrary to law in
such cases made and provided.

The prisoner was set to the bar by the Sheriff of this county
and charged with the offence of assault to which he pleads not guilty
and desires witnesses appear to wit, John the property of Thomas
Cowan and Dray and Abbot, who were examined touching the
premises and the prisoner heard by Counsel in his own defence.

Whereupon it is considered by the Court that the prisoner ought
to be tried for the said offence at the next Court to be holden
for this county, and it is ordered that the said John Carter find
security for his appearance at the next Court himself in the sum
of two hundred dollars and two securities in the sum of one hundred
dollars each, and in default thereof stand committed to the custody
of the Sheriff.

Lambert Poirer and David Widdowson having produced to the Court
a receipt from the Sheriff of this County for the sum of twenty dollars
therefore it is ordered that they have leave to retail goods wares and
merchandise of foreign growth and manufactures as a hawkers &
peddlers for the space of one year from the date hereof.

On the motion of Ulrich Jordan who made oath according to law
for administration with the will annexed on the estate of Mary Brown
and the same is granted him on giving bond & security. Whereupon
the said Ulrich Jordan with James Dwyer and John McWhorter his
securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the presence of
the Court and allow for the said Ulrich Jordan and his heirs &
administrators on the estate of the said deceased.
