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William Washington (of South) comes into court and undertakes for the defendant that in case he shall be cast in this action at the suit of the plaintiff, he shall satisfy and pay the condemnation of this court or render his body to prison in discharge thereof or that he the said William Washington is ill as it has been thought upon the defendant Arthur Washington is discharged

Mills Enright comes into court and undertakes for the defendant that in case he shall be cast in this action at the suit of the plaintiff, he shall satisfy and pay the condemnation of this court or render his body to prison in discharge thereof or that he the said Mills Enright will do it for him, Whereupon the said Mills Enright delivers up the body of the defendant into the custody of the sheriff and the said Mills Enright from his undertaking is discharged

And this defendant in his own proper person engaged the plaintiff's action to be just and that he owes the debt in the declaration mentioned in manner and form as against him the plaintiff hath explained Therefore it is considered by the court that the plaintiff sues against the said defendant forty five pounds North Carolina Currency and his Costs by him shewed his debt in this behalf reported and the defence is money due But this judgment except the Costs is to be discharged by the payment of twenty one pounds North Carolina Currency but if paid in Virginia or Currency may be dischargeable by the payment of sixteen pounds eleven shillings and nine pence and interest thereon after the rate of 5 per Centum per annum from the 28th day of January 1794 till judgment be had the plaintiff by his attorney pays the defendant in custody of the Sheriff of this county and the Opinion of the Court being taken they consider that the defendant is released and he was accordingly discharged from the custody of the Sheriff

Whereupon the following writ is to be deducted from the above judgment to wit February 7th 1794 By your order on George M. Williams a capient for eight pounds ten shillings and nine pence
