Ejectment

The persons to whom the matters in difference between the parties in the above suits were referred, this day made their reports in the following manner to wit: The undersigned to whom has been referred by rule of the Southampton Court entered by consent of parties the decision of the three actions of Ejectment between John Peters and his former wife plaintiffs and David Musson and Patsy his wife defendants depending in said Court do make the following award first that the plaintiffs have judgment against the defendants (the plaintiffs paying costs) for $\frac{2}{3}$ parts of the three hundred and forty six acres of land divided by Philip Person to his son Timothy and called the quarter plantation of which land the said Timothy did seize and while an infant, which two fifths are to be allotted and set apart to the plaintiffs by commissioners to be appointed by the said Court, and to be allotted by the Court successer the referees of said decision and allotments to be done in equal portion by the parties and the commissioners to make their report to the Court. Secondly that the plaintiffs at their last have judgment against the defendants for $\frac{2}{3}$ parts of two hundred and sixty nine and one half acres of land by estimation, namely called the creek land bounded on one of opinion descended to Timothy Person from Philip Person his father and to Philip Person from Patsy Person brother of said Philip after the date of Philip Person last will and testament which said two fifths are to be allotted and set apart to the plaintiffs as aforesaid and the commissioners to make report as aforesaid. Thirdly and lastly that the plaintiffs have judgment at their last against the defendants for two fifths parts of nine hundred acres of land which land one one of opinion descended to Timothy Person from Philip Person his father, and to Philip Person from his brother Patsy Person after the date of Philip Person last will and testament which said $\frac{2}{3}$ are to be allotted and set apart as first mentioned to the plaintiffs, and the commissioners to make report as aforesaid having
